No late entries accepted

Finalists will be notified by Wednesday September 14 2011. If your art programme/ project is shortlisted as a finalist, we will require an A2 storyboard depicting your programme/project for display at the **Waikato Community Arts Awards** at Southwell School on **Wednesday October 5 2011**. The board will need to be visually appealing and is a great way to promote and show case the wonderful creative work your school is involved in.

For your school to be eligible for the award, the programme/ project **must have** met the following criteria :

1. The arts programme / project has had significant student input throughout the planning and/or creation phases. Indicate the numbers of student/ staff and community involved.
2. The arts programme / project needs to be completed prior to application and evidence can be provided of this through photography, video, or CD.
3. The arts programme /project was completed within the last two years.
4. The programme / project had a budget of less than \$2000.
5. The school must be located within any of the 10 local authorities within the greater Waikato region.
6. The programme / project has enhanced the school environment / had a positive impact.

The arts programme/ project **may also have** the following:

- Involvement from a community artist or group.
- An ongoing plan for further development (please include).
- Publicity through local press (please include).
- Evaluative information about benefit to students involved (please include).
